Fingerprinting: The State of California requires that all individuals working with children/youth be fingerprinted and registered with the California Department of Justice. OASES will be fingerprinting all new volunteers accepted into the program and conducting a criminal background check. Turnaround for the DOJ processing is variable, but usually takes less than one week. During this time you may not work alone with children/youth. Should OASES receive from the Department of Justice either a 1) notification that the volunteer has a criminal record, or 2) subsequent arrest notification for any volunteer, s/he will immediately be ineligible for the program.

Tuberculosis (TB) Test: The State of California requires that all individuals working with children/youth must get a TB test on an annual basis. We will ask you to provide an original copy of test results taken within the last year (chest x-ray results taken within the last five years will also be accepted).
